Sub: - APEPDCL-Corporate Office-VSP- Regulation No 2 of 2023 – Levy of FPCCA on monthly basis for the consumption month of **January-2026** included in **March-2026** CC bills on provisional basis subject to true-up at the end of the financial year – Note approved – Placing in Website – Necessary action - Requested.

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In the reference cited (1) Hon'ble APERC has issued Regulation No 2 of 2023 Dt.29.03.2023 regarding levy of FPPCA on provisional basis with effect from the consumption month of April-2023 subject to true-up at the end of the Financial Year. As per above Regulation, licensee has to include FPPCA for January-2026 to be included in CC bills for the month of March-2026.

Necessary approval has been accorded by the Chairman & Managing Director/APEPDCL vide reference 2<sup>nd</sup> cited as follows:

- a. To include Fuel & Power Purchase Cost Adjustment (FPPCA) amounting to Rs.0.40 / Unit for the month of January-2026 as per Regulation No.2 of 2023, in March-2026 bill uniformly for all categories of consumers based on the consumption (Kwh / Kvah).
- b. To place the details/gist of FPPCA computed for the month of January-2026 on APEPDCL web site-> Regulatory compliance tab.
- c. To raise FPPCA bill on Government in respect of consumers who are provided 100 percent tariff subsidies under section 65 of Electricity Act, 2003.

In this connection it requested to arrange to include FPPCA amount of Rs.0.40 per unit for January-2026 consumption in March-2026 CC bills of all categories and arrange to place the details of FPPCA computation for January-2026 on APEPDCL web site-> Regulatory compliance tab. (Copy enclosed).

However, as per Clause 4 (A) of Regulation No.2 of 2023, the FPPCA is allowed to be recovered on monthly basis automatically up to a limit of 40 Paise per unit. Rest of the FPPCA is to be claimed in the final true-up by filing before the Honorable APERC.

Hence FPPCA @40 Paise per unit of consumption for **January' 2026** is raised in CC bills of **March-2026**.
